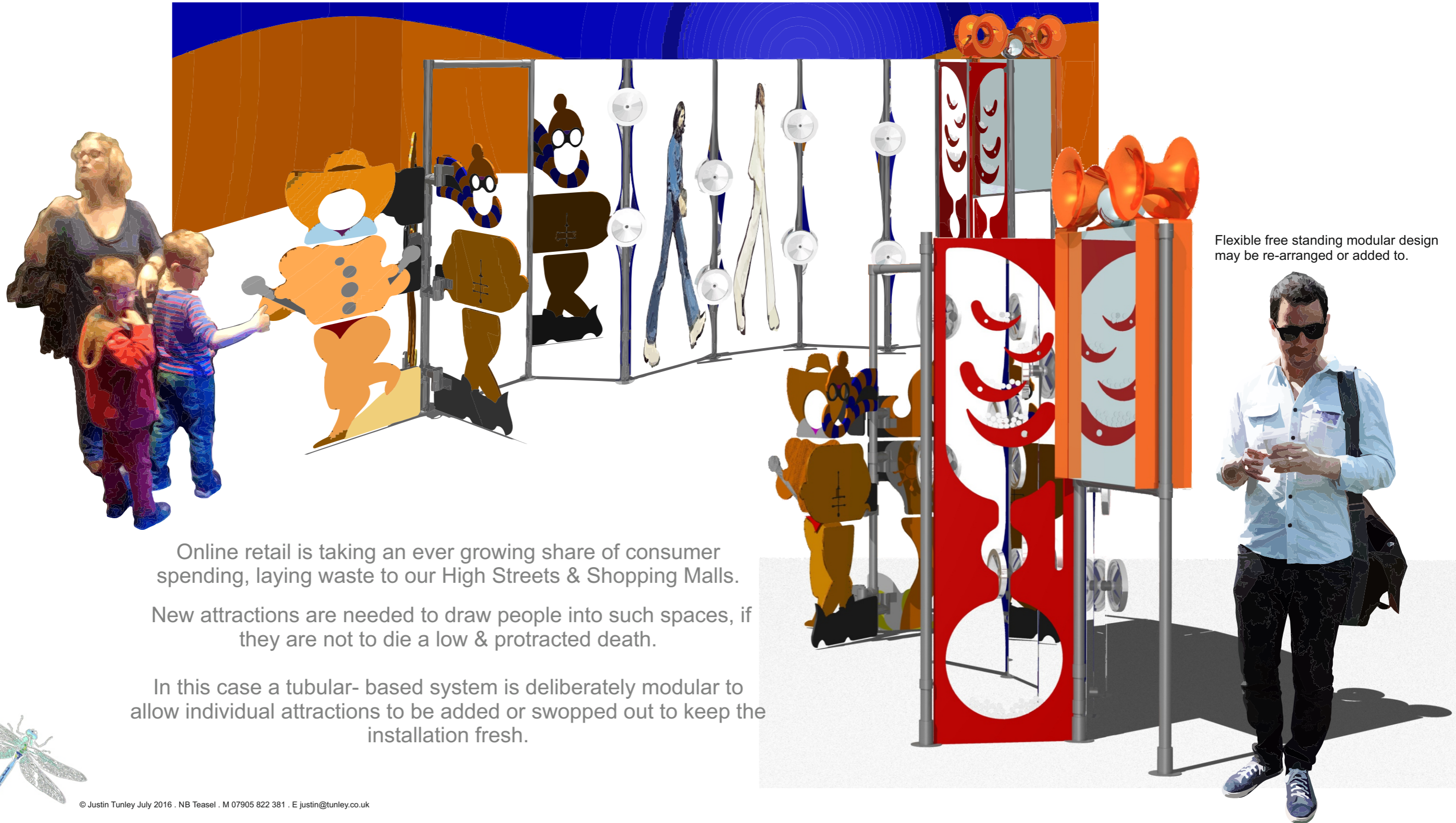

Rotating interchangeable 'selfie' boards

Section of distorting mirrors- rotating hand-wheels adjust distortion



Flexible free standing modular design may be re-arranged or added to.

Online retail is taking an ever growing share of consumer spending, laying waste to our High Streets & Shopping Malls.

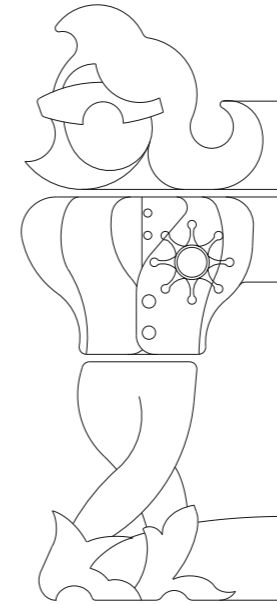
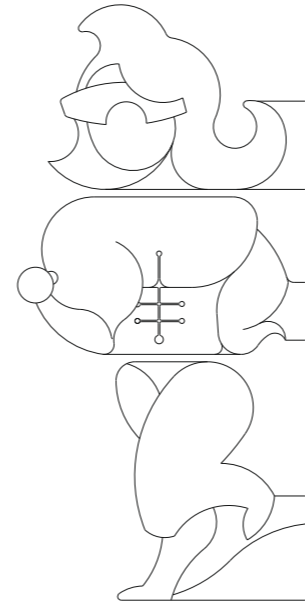
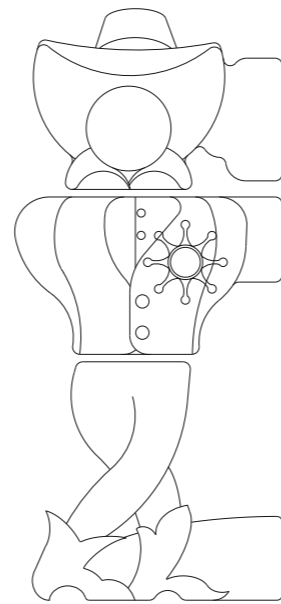
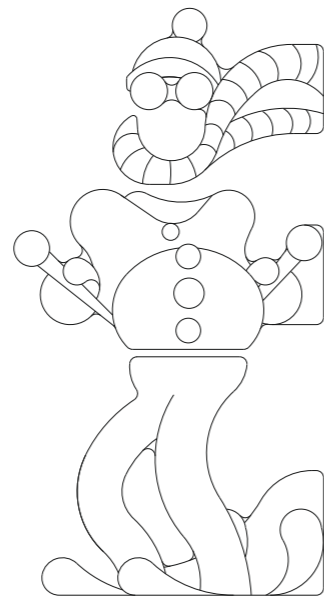
New attractions are needed to draw people into such spaces, if they are not to die a low & protracted death.

In this case a tubular- based system is deliberately modular to allow individual attractions to be added or swapped out to keep the installation fresh.



Multi-media module- web-cam 'reflection' may be distorted by intermediate software.

Fabricated brass/ copper shroud to screen/ speakers.



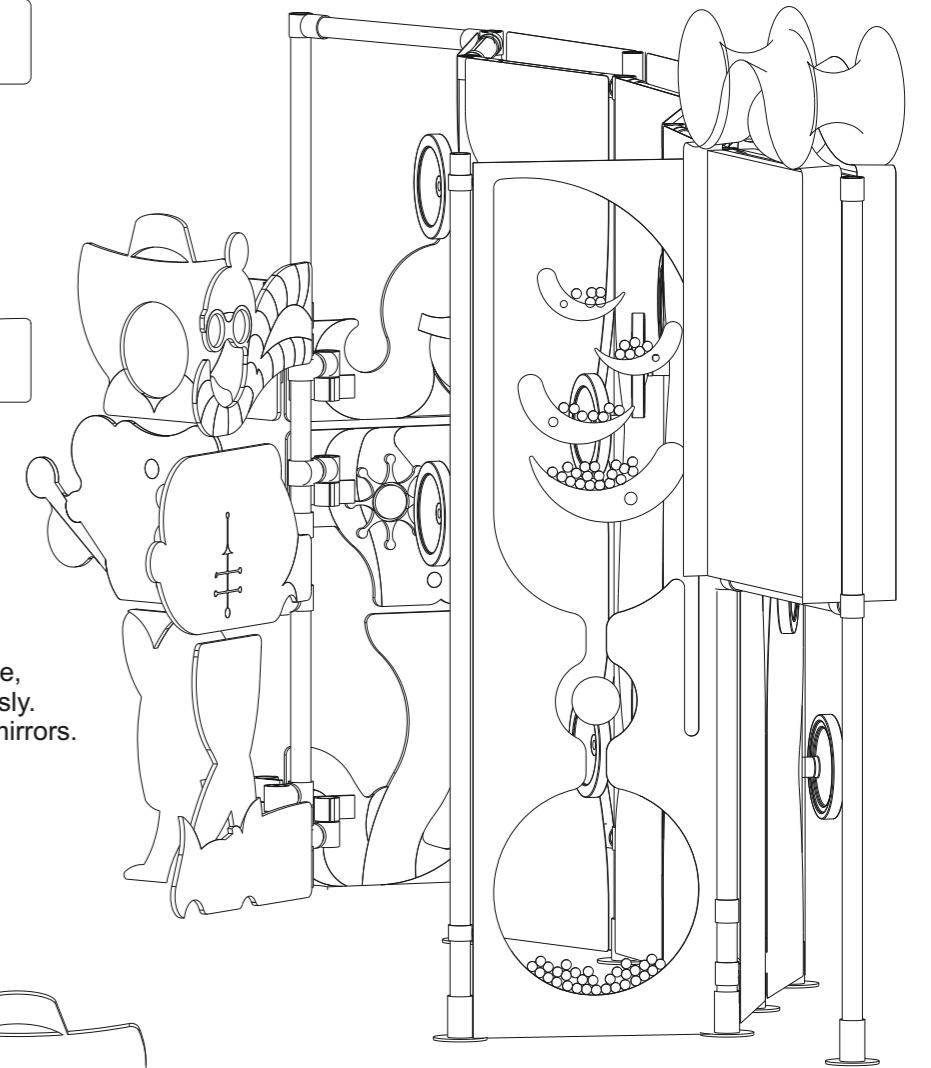
Some elements may be added to or rotated, to keep the installation fresh. Here a glass sandwiched plywood bagatelle board, using coins, noisily falling over a brass bell,

Kee-Klump alloy tube/ fixing system

600 x 2,100 polished ss distorting mirrors- reflect bot users & surrounding murals.

'Selfie' panels rotate around central pole, allowing several to be used simultaneously. May be positioned to reflect with distorting mirrors.

Polished alloy hand wheels



A tubular framework is based around the well established 'Kee-Klump' system, allowing major alterations using a simple allen-key

The key to attraction is novelty, with modules constantly altered & swapped out. Modules may include reconditioned arcade games or contemporary interactive kinetic sculpture.

25mm CNC routed ply, Painted & varnished.
